Trustworthy, Loyal,

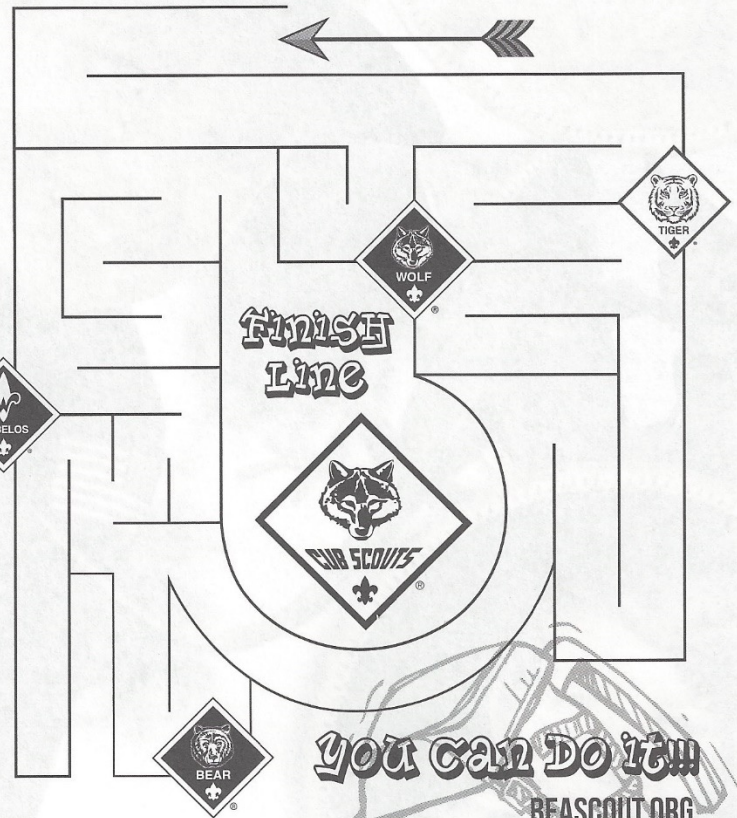
Helpful, Friendly,
