**RESOLVED,** that the aggregate original principal amount of the approved proposed financing shall not exceed \$2,883,793.00 and shall bear interest as set forth in the financing proposal and shall contain such options to purchase by the District as set forth therein; and that the proceeds of the approved proposed financing may be applied to reimburse the District for expenditures made after the effective date of this resolution for the purpose for which said proceeds are authorized, or on or prior to such date if the Board of Education has adopted a prior statement of intent to issue bonds for such purpose; the foregoing statement of intent with respect to reimbursement is made in conformity with Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2 of the United States Treasury Department; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the School Business Official to negotiate and finalize the financing of the Ameresco Energy Project with Municipal Leasing Consultants, its Agents or Assignee, at such rate and for such principal amount, and to take any and all other actions necessary in connection with the financing proposal; and that the President of the Board is hereby authorized to execute any and all legal documents necessary to conclude the financing of the lease purchase agreement, subject to the approving opinion by the school's attorney Frazer & Feldman, LLP.
