WHEREAS, in 1995, amendments were made to the SEQRA Regulation (Part 617) to classify projects, which will be excluded from the requirements for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (Type II actions). The projects mentioned above are now classified as Type II actions as determined by 6NYCRR§617.5 and

WHEREAS, these projects fall under the following categories:

- A. Routine Maintenance and Repair 6NYCRR§617.5 (c)(1): Maintenance or repair involving no substantial change in an existing facility.
- B. Replace or Rehabilitation 6NYCRR§617.5 (c)(2): Replacement or rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, unless the word exceeds a threshold for a Type I action in 6NYCRR§617.5.

THEREFORE, as the lead agency for the SEQRA determination, all the above-reference projects fall under Categories "A," "B," or "C" above. The procedure for Type II actions, with regard to the SEQRA Process for Capital Projects noted above is "No Additional Required Action Under 6NYCRR§617.5(a)."
